



Online Registration for Bakuna Makati



- 1. Go to the website
- 2. Fill out the form
- 3. Read info about vaccine reactions
- 4. Secure a patient number
- 5. Receive a text message regarding the schedule and place of vaccination

Use of QR Code System for Contact Tracing


